Re: Right of Reply

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing on behalf of the Environmental Investigation Agency (EIA), a non-governmental organisation based in the United Kingdom, in relation to our intention to publish in a forthcoming report the assertion that your companies have been operating in the Forest Area (*Kawasan Hutan*) in Indonesia without the required forest release and certified under the Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil (RSPO), in breach of the RSPO's rules.

Based on the RSPO's rules, the unit of certification is required to comply with all applicable legal requirements (Criterion 2.1), and the unit of certification shall source Fresh Fruit Bunches (FFB) from legal and traceable suppliers (Criterion 2.3), including evidence of the legal status of the land. Therefore, we consider that any supplier supplying to an RSPO certified mill – whether certified or uncertified – should not be operating in the Forest Area.

Based on analysis of Indonesian [Ministry of Forestry Decree No. 36 of 2025](#), we have identified that you operate the following company areas as listed in this Decree and that these were operated by RSPO certified companies at the time of the Decree:

- Companies listed in Decree No. 36 of 2025 that operated by RSPO certified companies:

258, Pilar Wanapersada, PT

- Number of companies: 2
- Total area within Forest Area: 3604 hectares
- Area listed as in process for release: 50 hectares
- Area listed to be rejected: 3554 hectares

The purpose of this letter is to provide you with an opportunity to respond to the findings outlined above prior to publication.

We would welcome any comments you wish to make in response.

Please provide your response in writing by **24 August 2026**. If we do not receive a response by this date, we will proceed on the basis of the information available to us.
